

TARGET & FIELD EQUIPMENT DIVISIONS

OAA Age Classes A class is the combination of Age and Gender. Below is a chart of OAA Classes. All ages are as of December 31 of the year of the tournament.

**Pee Wee Division can use any equipment and will shoot from a 10m MAXIMUM on a 60cm target face

This is a summary of the type of equipment athletes are permitted to use when shooting for OAA Championships. It is the athlete's responsibility to use equipment that is in accordance with the rules and regulations of the OAA (not this document). If in doubt the athlete must show their equipment to the Judge before using it in competition. Any athlete found to be using equipment contravening OAA Rules may have his/her scores disqualified.
