

## **Team Selection - Archery Canada Winter Games 2023**

Archers must be members of Archery Ontario (AO) and maintain membership through the selection, training, and competition periods.

- 1) Candidates must notify the Coach and Manager by email of their intentions as soon as possible, but no later than Feb 28<sup>th</sup> 2022.
- 2) Candidates must provide a parent email contact and a coach email (if applicable)  
(**Note:** Parents will be copied on all communications between the Support Staff (Coach and Manager) and the Coach will be copied on any emails dealing with the selection, training and competition)
- 3) Candidates must compete in the AO Indoor Championships and at least 2 other Archery Canada (AC) registered 10-ring indoor competitions (the AC Championships are encouraged but a different 10-ring tournament may be substituted if arranged in advance with the staff. The AO score will be used but if the archer shoots more than 2 other 10-ring competitions, the highest will be considered. All 10-ring tournaments must be shot on a 40 cm 3-spot target at 18m, as used at the Games, regardless of the candidate's age classification under AO and AC Rules.  
(**Note:** while practicing is expected and recording scores at a practice is encouraged, practice scores are not shot under the same tournament "pressure")
- 4) Candidates must also compete at the Junior Challenge or the AO Outdoor Target Championships. If they shoot both events, the higher score will be considered.  
(**Note:** maintaining training and competition during the summer is important, as is supporting AO; this will also allow identification of an archer who has "suddenly peaked")
- 5) Archers must submit a copy of their scorecard (scan or photo) for every 10-ring tournament and the AO Target Championships/ Junior Challenge.  
(**Note:** the scorecards will allow the staff to confirm the published results)
